New Business: It was suggested that we should make more space for the garden tractors and try to advertise them a little more.

The question was asked if the track food stand could be opened up for the Mid-Penn Garden Tractor Pullers pulls if the Boy Scouts are not going to be there. It is OK with the club members. It was mentioned that this could help bring in a couple extra dollars for the Association.

There were a few problems mentioned about our antique tractor pulls at our shows. People don't want to pull against the guys with the supped up tractors with a lot of weights. It was mentioned that we need to work on our pulling rules.

It was also suggested that we should make our pulls a Buffalo Valley Points pull. That would help draw more tractor pullers in.

The question was asked, what are we going to do for our entertainment for next years shows? Ray Hummel mentioned that we could get Covert Action for \$900.00. This will need to be decided so we can get it in the spring show flyers for next year and get them booked.

Unfinished Business: Discussing doing a Halloween event, making a place to work at the show grounds, advertising on the restaurant t.v.'s, installing a motion light on the barn, rebuilding the BBQ pit and getting a roof for the BBQ pit.
